APPLICATION DEADLINE: FRIDAY, JUNE 30TH

RULES & REGULATIONS

Any unmarried girl between the ages of 10-14, (10 by January 1st, 2017) is eligible to enter this pageant provided she is a resident of Wirt County, or attending Wirt County schools. Former Wirt County Fair Princesses are ineligible. Contestants cannot currently hold another title from another fair or festival, nor can she compete for another title during her reign as Wirt Co. Fair Princess. Once an application has been turned in to the pageant committee, the contestant cannot compete in another pageant, prior to the Wirt County Fair Princess Pageant.

Each contestant is required to be sponsored by a Wirt County resident, business or organization which is responsible for the **entry fee of \$75.00**. This entry fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE** and must be attached to the official application at the time of submission. Each contestant will be required to complete the official application.

ENTRY DEADLINE: No contestant will be accepted into the pageant after the entry deadline of Friday June 30th 2017.

PAGEANT REHEARSALS: All contestants will be expected to attend pageant rehearsals and no one will be excused without prior consent from the pageant director. Tardiness or failing to attend rehearsals may be grounds for dismissal from pageant festivities and directly impact your score. If you have to miss a practice or if you are going to be late, it is **YOUR** responsibility to call **Katelyn Cottrell (304) 494-0028** to let her know you will not be attending. It is also **your** responsibility to get with another contestant to find out what you have missed.

CONTESTANT PRIZE PACKAGE: Each contestant will contribute items for contestant's prize package. If there are five contestants, we will put together six prize packages. One for each contestant and one for the former Princess. You will be asked to contribute 6 items which will be used to make up these packages. Items may include key chains, lip gloss, lotion, etc. Please do not bring any thing that can not tolerate the heat...for example, no chocolates. Your sponsor may be able to help with this.

WIRT COUNTY FAIR PRINCESS'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Princess of the Wirt County Fair will be expected to be present and accessible at the Wirt County Fair grounds each day of the fair. A schedule will be supplied by the pageant director with activities highlighted, that the princess will be **required** to attend. It is **mandatory** that the Princess is present at the LIVESTOCK SHOW, SALE AND YOUTH GAMES, among other things.

Appropriate attire is required the Princess at all times when she is representing the Wirt County Fair. The Princess is also expected to be kind, respectful and to act appropriately while representing the Wirt County Fair.

The Princess is also expected to help put together the prize package for the next years Princess! It is the **Princesses responsibility** to gather items that will be used to create a gift package (of equal value to the one they receive) for next years Princess.

You are welcome to attend parades, but you are responsible for all the fees and arrangements, with the exception of the Wirt County Christmas parade, 4th of July parade and Homecoming parade.

We also urge you to attend other fairs and festivals as guest royalty....this is NOT mandatory. You just need to talk with your director prior to the event.

THERE IS A MEETING SCHEDULED AT GIOVANNIS TO GO OVER ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS. THIS IS A MANDATORY MEETING. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE DATE AND TIME OF THIS MEETING BY EMAIL OR BY PHONE. **EACH CONTESTANT MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. I WILL BE TAKING A PHOTOGRAPH OF EACH CONTESTANT AT THIS MEETING.**
